

Step By Step Assembly Instructions

PRE-ASSEMBLY PREPARATION

1. Please check the pack contents before attempting to assemble this product. A full checklist of components is given in this leaflet. If any components are missing, please contact the retailer from whom you bought this product.
2. This product is **HEAVY**, it should be assembled as near as possible to the point of use. **TAKE CARE WHEN LIFTING** to avoid personal injury and (or) damage to the product.
3. This product takes approximately **60 MINUTES** to assemble with **2 PEOPLE**.
4. The fittings pack contains **SMALL ITEMS** which should be **KEPT AWAY FROM YOUNG CHILDREN**.
5. Read this leaflet in full before commencing assembly.
6. You will require a crosshead screwdriver and an open ended spanner to assemble this product.


Step 1

Insert the four wooden dowels (N) into the headboard and footboard. This will assist in the alignment of the siderail. Screw the eight threads (F) into the headboard and footboard and tighten by hand.





Step 2

Locate the side rails onto the threads protruding from the headboard. Locate the washer & Nut (G) onto the threads and secure by hand at first. Tighten evenly using the open ended spanner (Provided).



IMPORTANT NOTE.

Ensure that when the side rails are in position the holes on the slat support rail are facing upwards.




Step 3 - Locate the side rails onto the threads protruding from the footboard. Locate the washer & nut onto the threads and secure by hand at first. Tighten using the open ended spanner (Provided).




Step 4 - Attach the brackets (M) to the headboard and footboard using the screws (I) inserted into the pre-drilled pilot holes. Tighten using a crosshead screwdriver.






- Step 5** - First attach the centre rail support leg(O) into the underneath of the centre rail(D), and secure using the bolt and washer(P).
 - Locate the centre rail(D) into the headboard and footboard brackets, and secure using the nuts(K) and bolts(J). Tighten using the open ended spanner(H)

Please note.

The holes in the slat support rail should be facing upwards.

- Step 6** - Push fit two plastic caps onto either end of the slat. Push fit the slat into the pre-drilled pilot holes. Please note that it may require a light tap with a soft hammer to secure the plastic end caps into the holes. Repeat this step with the other 31/ 33 slats.
 The assembly is now complete.
